Math Department Weighted Categories:

Math department grades will be weighted as follows:

Assessment	75%
Assignments	20%
Participation	5%

Students will be required to show work on all assignments. If no work is shown, no credit will be given. **Showing your work means:**

- Show as many steps as your teacher showed in the example (your grade depends on it)
- Circle or box your answer

Math Department Citizenship Policy:

All math students will begin each quarter with a Satisfactory Citizenship Grade.

Teachers will evaluate behavior and participation throughout the quarter based on the citizenship guidelines (see school-wide disclosure). Adjustments will be made accordingly.

Math Department Late Work Policy

- All students will receive 4 math vouchers at the beginning of each quarter. These vouchers can be used to turn in **completed** late work, (for full credit of earned score), use the hall pass, borrow pencil, or for extra credit at the end of the quarter.
- All late work turned in without a voucher will receive 50% credit, (of the earned score), until one week after the Unit Assessment.
- All late work, with or without a voucher, is due no later than one week after the Unit Assessment.
- No late work will be accepted after the Unit deadline.

Honor Requirements

Students are to maintain an 84% Assessment average and 84% homework average per quarter, or they will be placed on probation for the following quarter. If, at the end of the following quarter, they have not met the requirement, they will then be transferred out of the current honors course.

Assessment Expectations

The Math Department designed all assessments to be completed during one class period. Students will need to complete the assessment during class and will not be allowed to return at a later time to complete it.

Assessment Retakes

Students will be given the opportunity to retake one Assessment per quarter. In order to retake the assessment the student must do the following:

- Have all unit assignments completed with a C grade or better.
- Re-do the Assessment Review.
- Complete an assessment correction as per teacher instruction.
- All of the above must be completed within one week of notice.
- The final assessment grade will be the average of the original and the retake scores.
- Assessment Retakes need to be finished in one sitting. Please plan accordingly.

After School Math Tutoring

Math Tutoring will be held Tuesdays after school from 3 – 4 p.m. This is a great opportunity for students to get help with math assignments. It will be held in Room 404 (Mrs. Allred's room). Students need to bring the assignment(s) they are struggling with.
